Teams will travel by coach for the 45 minute journey to Spier in the heart of South Africa's Western Cape Winelands where players and their partners will enjoy a fun-filled day of traditional African song and dance, continuous food, drinks and entertainment along with the opportunity to sample special wines and view wildlife all in the company of teams from around the world.

The beer and wine will flow on arrival and be followed by 3-hours of continuous Barbeque lunch with meats, salads and desserts along with tea and coffee, food and drinks (wine, beer, soft drinks and water) served from various areas of the estate.

Entertainment will include the colourful Cape Minstrels plus the estate's own traditional African entertainers with singing and dancing, face-painting etc. For those not feeling the strain of the previous day's play Spier guides will be available to take small groups on a 20-minute walk to observe the bird and plant life and other attractions on this magnificent
