Colonia, Uruguay

This full day excursion includes a ferry crossing of the Rio de la Plata on Buquebus to a fascinating, historical city founded in 1531 by the Spanish.

DO NOT FORGET you are required to take your **PASSPORT**

On arrival in Colonia you will be met & will embark upon a city tour with an English speaking guide. With one story buildings & old fashioned cobblestone pave, Colonia is a delightful & compact town to wander.

Colonia was founded in 1531 by the Spanish who built a fortress suitably protected by an array of cannons dotted around the balustrades & used this as their staging point for their colonization efforts into Uruguay, Southern Brasil & Argentina.

The old fort is one of the highlight points on the city tour, as is the famous Colonia lighthouse which you can scale by way of an internal staircase to the light balcony.

Built on the banks of the Rio de La Plata it is a quaint town with its series of tree-lined cobbled streets that meet in a central market square, dominated by a glistening whitewashed church that quite rightly boasts the most amazing acoustics.

Lunch is included at a typical & traditional Colonia restaurant.

You will return to the Buquebus ferry wharf in Colonia to complete Uruguay departure & Argentine border entry formalities, then board the ferry for the return voyage to Buenos Aires.



The Colonia full day excursion inclusive of an English speaking guide will operate:

Tuesday 19th & Wednesday 20th, with transfers departing from your hotel at 0700hrs & the return to Buenos Aires arriving at 1830hrs. Includes lunch.
